## SANDHAM GARDENS PLAYPARK PROJECT

Contractors are on site at Sandham Gardens Playpark, replacing the zip-wire and children's swing that were damaged in 2020, as well as upgrading the rockers, installing sensory equipment and other minor improvements.

Temporary fencing has been put in place to minimise disruption to the use of the park, and, subject to the weather, the works are hoped to be completed in a week.

Town Mayor Paddy Lightfoot said 'Due to a number of factors, including Covid, this project has responded to issues raised during public consultation, and we have allocated funding both for new equipment and to replace the equipment damaged last year'.

Cllr Lightfoot added 'We have put in place measures to enable continued use of the areas not affected by the works, and we will be looking at future projects in the Park in the future as part of working party priorities.
