EASTERN GARDENS PROJECT PROGRESSES

The £200,000 project to re-provide public toilets at Eastern Gardens, Sandown, has progressed with the delivery of the new accessible block, including baby changing facilities, public showers, and contactless payment system .

Sandown Town Mayor Cllr Paddy Lightfoot said ‘We’ve been able to adapt the original proposals to include the comments made by partner agencies, and we will be discussing other improvements at our November meeting of the Town Council’.

Paddy added ‘Eastern Garden’s follows the reprovision at St John’s, and we are planning further reprovision following public consultation, with funding included in the 2023-24 Budget’.

Sandown Town Council have also invested in the Beach Safety Service, improvements at Sandham Gardens, Commemorative Services at the Cenotaph, as well as in the High Street Task Force initiative and Bay wide Place Plan Project.

Cllr Lightfoot concluded ‘We’d like thank the contractors, local stakeholders, and all involved in the project, for the progress made and for their contribution to how this project fits in with the wider ambitions of the Town Council, following engagement with the local community’.
