ST JOHN'S TOILETS - COMMENCEMENT OF WORKS

St John's Toilets in Sandown, have been closed following recent damage and the commencement of a major reprovision of Toilets on the site.

Town Mayor Gary Young said 'Following public meetings and a recent survey of residents, the reprovision has started, with a planned programme of work due for completion early in May'.

Following an extensive tendering process, the contract has been awarded to Danfo, who have also provided amenities in Shanklin, Newport and other locations on the Island.

Deputy Mayor Paul Brading added 'This is a major project for the Town, and we plan to take forward the reprovision of Eastern Gardens later in the year, given the positive support we have received in the recent public consultation'.

The project team are addressing some on site issues, before the substantive work on the almost £100,000 project begins.

Cllr Young concluded 'The new units will include facilities for contactless payments, and also other Covid safe features, responding to the issues identified by residents'.
