COUNCIL CONSULTS ON BUDGET

Following Sandown Town Council's Town Meeting, attended by over 100 residents, on Monday 21st January, the Sandown Community have further opportunities to contribute to the 2020/21 Budget setting process, and help identify key spending priorities.

Town Mayor Gary Young said 'We've had really good feedback from the Town Meeting, and hope this presentation provides residents with the opportunity to see how resources have been allocated, and also how they could be allocated in the future.'

Residents have already highlighted the need to renovate or replace Eastern Gardens Toilets, as well as other Public Conveniences if possible, increase support for voluntary groups, and support the public realm.

CLr Young added 'We've already taken forward projects discussed at the meeting, including painting the Hall at the Centre and freeing up 2 meeting rooms, as well as celebrating recent successes in the Town, and we hope the 2020/21 Budget will continue our commitment to invest in amenities benefitting residents and tourists, but within our limited resources'.

The Consultation is located in the reception at the Broadway Centre, from 9am to Noon (staff will be available to answer questions), week days until Friday 7th February, with information collected used to help shape the Budget meeting on Monday 24th February.
