Sandown Town Council are continuing to support the Coronavirus Helpline (01983 823600) and the guidance being provided to the local community, and are providing the Community Hub for the Bay.

At present around 50 Volunteers, from the Bay, have volunteered through Community Action (IW) and are being supported by the Bay Hub; and around 20 requests for support have been received and responded to across the Bay.

Sandown Town Mayor Gary Young said 'We recognise this is a very difficult time for the local community and we are providing as much support as possible for the local community, at the same time as appreciating the need to keep all involved in delivering support as safe as possible, and following the guidance'.

Deputy Mayor Paul Brading added 'It is important for all of us to follow the guidance being provided, and the Town Council, with Lake and Shanklin, thank all those that have volunteered to help vulnerable residents and those that need help in the Bay'.

The Town Council have also followed guidance and have closed all Public Toilets in Sandown, the Steven Jenkins Playground and Skatepark, as well as the Broadway Centre.
