Sandown Line Dancing instructor and choreographer Katrina Kelly, with regular line dancers and Town Council guests, joined together in a special dance to launch Healthy Lifestyle initiatives on Valentine's Day, February 14th, at the Broadway Centre Sandown.

Town Mayor Gary Young said 'The Centre is increasingly being used for activities, like line-dancing, which promote healthy lifestyles in a fun and friendly setting, and we plan to provide more resources to support this approach'.

Voluntary support and funding enabled a defibrillator to be provided at the Centre, the provision of space for nail cutting service for older people, a therapies room, and outdoor garden with Green Town Volunteers.
